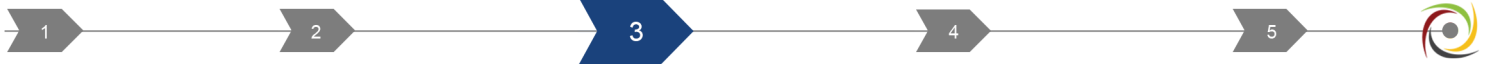


What is needed to enable genuine engagement?
